A BILL

To prohibit for a one-year period beginning September 30, 2013, the implementation, operation, and coordination of a Federal Data Services Hub or any similar database system for determining or verifying eligibility under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITING IMPLEMENTATION OF FEDERAL**
2 **DATA SERVICES HUB UNDER PATIENT PRO-**
3 **TECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT FOR**
4 **ONE-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING SEPTEMBER**
5 **30, 2013.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
7 retary of Health and Human Services may not implement,
8 operate, or coordinate a Federal Data Services Hub or any
9 similar database system for purposes of determining or
10 verifying eligibility under part B of part I of subtitle E
11 of title I of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
12 Act (Public Law 111–148) during the one-year period be-
13 ginning on September 30, 2013.

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
