A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Adjustment Act to exclude raisins
from agricultural marketing orders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF RAISINS FROM AGRICULTURAL**
4 **MARKETING ORDERS.**

5 (a) EXCLUSION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 8c(2)(A) of the Ag-
7 ricultural Adjustment Act (7 U.S.C. 608c(2)(A)), re-
8 enacted with amendments by the Agricultural Mar-
9 keting Agreement Act of 1937, is amended by strik-

1 ing “and the products of honeybees” and inserting
2 “the products of honeybees, and raisins”.

3 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Such Act is
4 further amended by striking “raisins,” each place it
5 appears in the following provisions:

6 (A) Section 8c(6)(I) (7 U.S.C. 608c(6)(I)).

7 (B) Section 8e(a) (7 U.S.C. 608e–1).

8 (b) EXISTING ORDERS.—Effective on the date of the
9 enactment of this Act, no order issued by the Secretary
10 pursuant to section 8c of the Agricultural Adjustment Act
11 (7 U.S.C. 608c), as in effect prior to such enactment, shall
12 have any force or effect with respect to raisins.

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
