Mr. ALEXANDER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To prohibit the revocation or withholding of Federal funds
to programs whose participants carry out voluntary religious
activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom to Pray Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON WITHHOLDING FEDERAL FUNDS**
6 **TO PROGRAMS WHOSE PARTICIPANTS CON-**
7 **DUCT VOLUNTARY RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for the Fed-
9 eral Government to revoke or withhold Federal financial
10 assistance that would otherwise be provided to any recipi-

1 ent of such assistance on the basis of religious activities
2 that are conducted voluntarily and initiated by partici-
3 pants in a program or activity carried out by such recipi-
4 ent.

5 (b) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act
6 shall be construed to authorize the United States or any
7 State or political subdivision thereof—

8 (1) to sponsor a religious activity;

9 (2) to prohibit a recipient of Federal financial
10 assistance from ensuring that a religious activity
11 does not materially and substantially interfere with
12 the orderly conduct of the program or activities car-
13 ried out by such recipient;

14 (3) to require any person to participate in pray-
15 er or other religious activity; or

16 (4) to compel any employee or agent of a pro-
17 gram or activity that is carried out by a recipient of
18 Federal financial assistance to participate in an ac-
19 tivity if the content of the speech at the activity is
20 contrary to the beliefs of the employee or agent.

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
