A BILL

To amend the hold harmless provision for career and technical education assistance grants to States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Career and Technical
5 Education Equity Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. HOLD HARMLESS.**

7 Section 111(a)(5)(A) of the Carl D. Perkins Career
8 and Technical Education Act of 2006 (20 U.S.C.
9 2321(a)(5)(A)) is amended to read as follows:

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—No State shall receive
2 an allotment under this section for a fiscal year
3 that is less than 90 percent of the allotment the
4 State received under this section for the pre-
5 ceding fiscal year.”.

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
