A BILL

To provide for the placement of certain synthetic drugs on Schedule I under the Controlled Substances Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Synthetic Cathinones
5 Control Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITION OF SYNTHETIC DRUGS TO SCHEDULE I**
7 **OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
9 sion of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 801 et

1 seq.), the Attorney General shall, not later than 60 days
2 after the date of the enactment of this Act, issue a final
3 order that schedules the following substances on schedule
4 I under section 202(c) of that Act (21 U.S.C. 812(c)):

5 (1) 3,4-methylenedioxymethcathinone (methyl-
6 one).

7 (2) Naphthylpyrovalerone (naphyrone).

8 (3) 4-fluoromethcathinone (flephedrone).

9 (4) 4-methoxymethcathinone (methedrone; Bk-
10 PMMA).

11 (5) Ethcathinone (N-ethylcathinone).

12 (6) 3,4-methylenedioxyethcathinone (ethylone).

13 (7) Beta-keto-N-methyl-3,4-benzodioxymolybutan-
14 amine (butylone).

15 (8) N,N-dimethylcathinone (metamfepramone).

16 (9) Alpha-pyrrolidinopropiophenone (alpha-
17 PPP).

18 (10) 4-methoxy-alpha-pyrrolidinopropiophenone
19 (MOPPP).

20 (11) 3,4-methylenedioxyalpha-pyrrolidinopro-
21 piophenone (MDPPP).

22 (12) Alpha-pyrrolidinovalerophenone (alpha-
23 PVP).

24 (13) 6,7-dihydro-5H-indeno[5,6-d][1,3]dioxol-6-
25 amine (MDAI).

1 (14) 3-fluoromethcathinone.

2 (15) 4'-methyl- α -pyrrolidinobutiophenone
3 (MPBP).

4 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO REMOVE DEAD-
5 WOOD.—Subsection (c) of section 202 of the Controlled
6 Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 802) is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 “(c) CROSS REFERENCE TO SCHEDULES OF CON-
9 TROLLED SUBSTANCES.—Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V
10 shall consist of the drugs and other substances (by what-
11 ever official name, common or usual name, chemical name,
12 or brand name designated) that are set forth in the respec-
13 tive schedules in part 1308 of title 21, Code of Federal
14 Regulations, as they may be amended from time to time,
15 or in any successor regulation.”.

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
