Mr. MCKINLEY (for himself, Mr. DOYLE, Mr. JOHNSON of Ohio, and Mr. RYAN of Ohio) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To clarify that certain natural gas facilities are not subject to the Natural Gas Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATURAL GAS ACT JURISDICTION.**

4 Section 1 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717)
5 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(e) A person not otherwise subject to this Act shall
8 not become subject to this Act solely by reason of such
9 person’s construction or operation of a facility not other-
10 wise subject to this Act that liquefies, stores, processes,

1 or delivers natural gas for vehicular natural gas or other
2 end use purposes notwithstanding that natural gas may
3 be reinjected from the facility into an interstate pipeline,
4 provided that such reinjections are incidental to the facili-
5 ty's provision of natural gas for vehicular or other end
6 use purposes and are required by the operational, mainte-
7 nance, or safety needs of the facility.”.
