To prohibit United States voluntary contributions to the regular budget of the United Nations or any United Nations agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES VOLUNTARY**
4 **CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS**
5 **AND UNITED NATIONS AGENCIES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds made available to any
7 Federal department or agency may be used to make
8 United States voluntary contributions to the regular budg-
9 et of the United Nations or any United Nations agency.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) applies with
2 respect to funds made available for fiscal year 2014 and
3 subsequent fiscal years.
