A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the National Insti-
tutes of Health for the fiscal year ending September
30, 2014, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014:

4 For an additional amount for the National Institutes
5 of Health for carrying out title IV of the Public Health
6 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 281 et seq.), \$3,000,000,000, to
7 remain available until expended.

4 (b) ALTERNATIVE DEPRECIATION SYSTEM.—The
 5 table contained in subparagraph (B) of section 168(g)(3)
 6 of such Code is amended by inserting after the item relat-
 7 ing to subparagraph (C)(iv) the following new item:

“(C)(vi) 12”.

8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-
 10 graph (2), the amendments made by this section
 11 shall apply to property placed in service after the
 12 date of the enactment of this Act.

13 (2) SPECIAL RULE FOR BINDING CONTRACTS.—

14 (A) IN GENERAL.—In the case of any
 15 property for which there is a qualified written
 16 binding contract in effect before the date of the
 17 enactment of this Act, the amendments made
 18 by this section shall apply to property placed in
 19 service after December 31, 2014.

20 (B) QUALIFIED WRITTEN BINDING CON-
 21 TRACT.—For purposes of subparagraph (A),
 22 the term “qualified written binding contract”
 23 means a written binding contract with respect
 24 to which—

1 (i) the purchaser made a nonrefund-
2 able deposit at the time such contract was
3 entered into in an amount equal to or
4 greater than the lesser of—

5 (I) 10 percent of the cost of such
6 contract, or

7 (II) \$100,000,

8 (ii) the estimated production period of
9 the property under the contract exceeds 4
10 months, and

11 (iii) the total cost of such property ex-
12 ceeds \$200,000.

13 This Act may be cited as the “Inspiring Scientific Re-
14 search and Innovation Supplemental Appropriations Act,
15 2014”.

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
