A BILL

To amend the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to extend the period during which supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits are temporarily increased.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Extend Not Cut SNAP
3 Benefits Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY INCREASE IN SUPPLE-**
5 **MENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE BENEFITS.**

6 Section 101(a) of title I of division A of the American
7 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–
8 5; 123 Stat. 120) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “section 3(o)”
10 and inserting “section 3(u)”, and

11 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “2013” and in-
12 serting “2014”.

13 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

14 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
15 take effect on September 30, 2013.

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
