Mr. BURGESS (for himself, Mrs. CHRISTENSEN, Mr. MICHAUD, Ms. MCCOLLUM, Mr. GRIJALVA, Mr. KING of New York, Mr. LATTI, Mr. WHITFIELD, Mr. WITTMAN, Mrs. BUSTOS, and Mr. HONDA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a Veterans Health Care Stamp.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Health Care
5 Stamp Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. VETERANS HEALTH CARE STAMP.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—In order to afford a convenient
8 way for members of the public to contribute to funding

1 for the medical care and treatment of veterans, the United
2 States Postal Service shall provide for the issuance and
3 sale of a special postage stamp which shall be known as
4 the “Veterans Health Care Stamp”.

5 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The issuance and sale
6 of the Veterans Health Care Stamp shall be governed by
7 section 416 of title 39, United States Code (as last in ef-
8 fect, if expired), except that—

9 (1) all amounts becoming available from the
10 sale of the stamp shall be transferred to the Depart-
11 ment of Veterans Affairs in accordance with section
12 416(d) of such title; and

13 (2) the stamp—

14 (A) shall be issued in time for Veterans
15 Day of each year;

16 (B) shall bear such illustration, depiction,
17 design, or other image as the United States
18 Postal Service shall determine; and

19 (C) shall not be subject to any numerical
20 limitation under section 416(e)(1)(C) of such
21 title.

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
