Mr. RYAN of Ohio introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the award of the Distinguished Service Cross
to Robert L. Towles for acts of valor during the Vietnam
War.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR AWARD OF THE DISTIN-**
4 **GUISHED SERVICE CROSS TO SPECIALIST**
5 **FOUR ROBERT L. TOWLES FOR ACTS OF**
6 **VALOR DURING THE VIETNAM WAR.**

7 (a) WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.—Notwith-
8 standing the time limitations specified in section 3744 of
9 title 10, United States Code, or any other time limitation
10 with respect to the awarding of certain medals to persons

1 who served in the Armed Forces, the Secretary of the
2 Army may award the Distinguished Service Cross under
3 section 3742 of that title to Robert L. Towles for the acts
4 of valor referred to in subsection (b).

5 (b) ACTION DESCRIBED.—The acts of valor referred
6 to in subsection (a) are the actions of Specialist Four Rob-
7 ert L. Towles, on November 17, 1965, as a member of
8 the United States Army serving in the grade of Specialist
9 Four during the Vietnam War while serving in Company
10 D, 2d Battalion, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, for
11 which he was originally awarded the Bronze Star with “V”
12 Device.

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
