A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to increase the age limit for children using transferred Post-9/11 Educational Assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increased Age Limit
5 for Post-9/11 Education Assistance Dependents Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE OF AGE LIMIT TO USE TRANSFERRED**
7 **POST-9/11 EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE.**

8 (a) INCREASE IN AGE LIMIT.—Section 3319(h)(5) of
9 title 38, United States Code, is amended by striking “26
10 years” each place it appears and inserting “29 years”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this Act shall take effect as if included in the enactment
3 of the Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of
4 2008 (title V of Public Law 110–252).
