A BILL

To prohibit Department of State approval for the Russian space agency to build or operate a ground monitoring station in the United States unless such station does not raise counterintelligence or other national security concerns.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevent Russian Infil-
5 tration Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONAL PROHIBITION ON BUILDING OR OP-**
2 **ERATING A RUSSIAN SPACE AGENCY GROUND**
3 **MONITORING STATION IN THE UNITED**
4 **STATES.**

5 The Secretary of State may not approve a request
6 by the Russian space agency, Roscosmos, to build or oper-
7 ate a ground monitoring station in the United States, in-
8 cluding in any territory or possession of the United States,
9 until the Secretary of State, the Secretary of Defense, and
10 the Director of National Intelligence jointly certify to Con-
11 gress that any such proposed station does not raise coun-
12 terintelligence or other national security concerns.

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
