6 Section 114(c)(1) of the Medicare, Medicaid, and
7 SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 1395ww note),
8 as amended by section 3106 of Public Law 111–148, is
9 further amended—

10 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
11 by striking “for a 5-year period”; and

12 (2) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “for a 5-
13 year period,” before “section 412.536”.

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
