A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage of continuous glucose monitoring systems (CGMS) as durable medical equipment under Medicare, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare CGM Cov-
5 erage Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF CONTINUOUS GLUCOSE**
2 **MONITORING SYSTEMS (CGMS) AS DURABLE**
3 **MEDICAL EQUIPMENT (DME).**

4 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Section 1861(n) of the So-
5 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(n)) is amended by add-
6 ing at the end the following: “Such term also includes con-
7 tinuous glucose monitoring systems (including a trans-
8 mitter, receiver, sensors, and test strips required for
9 use).”.

10 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall apply to the implementation of moni-
12 toring systems occurring on or after January 1, 2015.

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
