Ms. JACKSON LEE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To extend the emergency unemployment compensation program until January 1, 2015.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unemployment Bene-
5 fits Extension Act of 2013” or the “Unemployed
6 Jobhunters Protection and Assistance Act of 2013”.

7 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY UNEMPLOYMENT COM-**
8 **PENSATION PROGRAM.**

9 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 4007(a)(2) of the Supple-
10 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;

1 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended by striking “January
2 1, 2014” and inserting “January 1, 2015”.

3 (b) FUNDING.—Section 4004(e)(1) of the Supple-
4 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;
5 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (I), by striking “and” at
7 the end;

8 (2) in subparagraph (J), by inserting “and” at
9 the end; and

10 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (J) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(K) the amendment made by section 2(a)
13 of the Unemployment Benefits Extension Act of
14 2013;”.

15 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
16 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
17 ment of the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (Public
18 Law 112–240).

19 **SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

20 It is the sense of Congress that the House of Rep-
21 resentatives and the Senate should reconvene on or before
22 December 18, 2013, to take appropriate action to enact
23 this legislation.

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
