## A BILL

To require the Director of National Intelligence to annually submit reports on violations of law or executive order by personnel of the intelligence community, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ANNUAL REPORT ON VIOLATIONS OF LAW OR**

4                   **EXECUTIVE ORDER.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Title V of the National Security

6       Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3091 et seq.) is amended by add-

7       ing at the end the following:

1   **“SEC. 509. ANNUAL REPORT ON VIOLATIONS OF LAW OR EX-**

2                 **ECUTIVE ORDER.**

3                 “(a) ANNUAL REPORTS REQUIRED.—The Director of  
4   National Intelligence shall annually submit to the congress-  
5   sional intelligence committees a report on violations of law  
6   or executive order by personnel of an element of the intel-  
7   ligence community that were identified during the previous  
8   calendar year.

9                 “(b) ELEMENTS.—Each report required under sub-  
10   section (a) shall include a description of, and any action  
11   taken in response to, any violation of law or executive  
12   order (including Executive Order 12333 (50 U.S.C. 3001  
13   note)) by personnel of an element of the intelligence com-  
14   munity in the course of such employment that, during the  
15   previous calendar year, was determined by the director,  
16   head, general counsel, or inspector general of any element  
17   of the intelligence community to have occurred or more  
18   than likely to have occurred.”.

19                 (b) INITIAL REPORT.—The first report required  
20   under section 509 of the National Security Act of 1947,  
21   as added by subsection (a), shall be submitted not later  
22   than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act.

23                 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
24   in the first section of the National Security Act of 1947

- 1 is amended by adding after the section relating to section
- 2 508 the following:

“See. 509. Annual report on violations of law or executive order.”.
