A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to authorize the Secretary of Homeland Security to award Urban Area Security Initiative grants to nonprofit organizations not located in high-risk urban areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AU-**
2 **THORITY TO AWARD URBAN AREA SECURITY**
3 **INITIATIVE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT ORGANI-**
4 **ZATIONS NOT LOCATED IN HIGH-RISK URBAN**
5 **AREAS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2003 of the Homeland
7 Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 604) is amended—

8 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
9 section (f); and

10 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
11 lowing new subsection (e):

12 “(e) SPECIAL RULE FOR GRANTS TO NONPROFIT
13 ORGANIZATIONS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of
14 law, the Secretary may award a grant under this section
15 to an organization (as described under section 501(c)(3)
16 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from
17 tax section 501(a) of such code) located in an area that
18 is not designated as a high-risk urban area.”.

19 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
20 subsection (a) apply with respect to a grant made after
21 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
