To amend title 39, United States Code, to allow the United States Postal Service to provide nonpostal services, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Expand Nonpostal
5 Services to Americans Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO OFFER NONPOSTAL SERVICES.**

7 Section 404 of title 39, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) in paragraph (7), by striking “and” at
2 the end;

3 (B) in paragraph (8), by striking the pe-
4 riod and inserting “; and”; and

5 (C) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(9) to provide nonpostal services.”; and

7 (2) by striking subsection (e).

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
