A BILL

To provide for a one-year extension of the Department of Veterans Affairs pilot program on assisted living services for veterans with traumatic brain injury.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Healing Our Heroes
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF DEPARTMENT OF VET-**
2 **ERANS AFFAIRS PILOT PROGRAM ON AS-**
3 **SISTED LIVING SERVICES FOR VETERANS**
4 **WITH TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.**

5 Section 1705 of the National Defense Authorization
6 Act for Fiscal Year 2008 (Public Law 110–181; 122 Stat.
7 491; 38 U.S.C. 1710C note) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “five-year pilot
9 program” and inserting “six-year pilot program”;
10 and

11 (2) in subsection (e)(1), by striking “the com-
12 pletion of the pilot program” and inserting “the date
13 on which the pilot program has been carried out for
14 five years”.

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
