3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO**
4 **PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR MO-**
5 **TION PICTURES, TELEVISION SHOWS, AND**
6 **OTHER AUDIOVISUAL PROGRAMS.**

7 No Federal department or agency may obligate or ex-
8 pend funds appropriated to the department or agency for

1 a fiscal year to provide technical assistance to any non-
2 government entity for the production of any motion pic-
3 ture, television show, documentary, music videos, commer-
4 cial advertisement, CD-ROM game, or other audiovisual
5 program.
