A BILL

To prohibit funds made available to the Department of Education or the Department of Justice from being used to provide postsecondary courses in prisons.

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR COLLEGE**
4 **COURSES IN PRISONS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds
6 made available to the Department of Education or the De-
7 partment of Justice shall be used to provide or assist in

- 1 providing a postsecondary course to an inmate in a Fed-
- 2 eral or State prison.
