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## A BILL

To prohibit further action on the proposed rule regarding changes to Medicare prescription drug benefit programs.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Keep the Promise to  
5       Seniors Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROTECTING SENIORS FROM CANCELLED PRE-**  
2 **SCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE, FEWER**  
3 **CHOICES, AND INCREASED PREMIUMS.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-  
5 retary of Health and Human Services shall not take any  
6 action (through promulgation of a final or interim final  
7 regulation, issuance of regulatory or program guidance,  
8 use of Federal payment audit procedures, or other enforce-  
9 ment or administrative action, policy, or practice) to im-  
10 plement any provision of the proposed regulation (relating  
11 to policy and technical changes to the Medicare Advantage  
12 and part D programs under the Medicare program) pub-  
13 lished on January 10, 2014 (79 Fed. Reg. 1918 et seq.)  
14 insofar as such regulation relates to the provisions of part  
15 D of title XVIII of the Social Security Act, including the  
16 application of such provisions to MA–PD plans under part  
17 C of such title.

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
