A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to collect and maintain data on the number of sexual assaults that occur on aircraft during flights in passenger air transportation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Airline Pas-
5 sengers from Sexual Assaults Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. SEXUAL ASSAULT DATA.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
8 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the

1 Federal Aviation Administration shall establish a program
2 to collect and maintain data on the number of sexual as-
3 saults that occur on aircraft during flights in passenger
4 air transportation.

5 (b) DATA AVAILABILITY.—The Administrator shall
6 make available to the public on the primary Internet Web
7 site of the Federal Aviation Administration the data main-
8 tained under subsection (a).

9 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the following defi-
10 nitions apply:

11 (1) AIR TRANSPORTATION.—The term “air
12 transportation” has the meaning given that term in
13 section 40102(a)(5) of title 49, United States Code,
14 and includes intrastate air transportation.

15 (2) AIRCRAFT.—The term “aircraft” has the
16 meaning given that term in section 40102(a)(6) of
17 title 49, United States Code.

18 (3) INTRASTATE AIR TRANSPORTATION.—The
19 term “intrastate air transportation” has the mean-
20 ing given that term in section 40102(a)(27) of title
21 49, United States Code.
