Mr. BRADY of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Labor to issue implementing regulations for drug testing under State unemployment compensation programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ready to Work Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE TO ISSUE REGULATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Labor
8 shall issue a final rule to carry out section 303(l)(1)(A)(ii)
9 of the Social Security Act.

1 (b) SPECIAL RULE IF INTERIM RULE NOT ISSUED
2 AFTER 180 DAYS.—If the Secretary of Labor has not
3 issued an interim final rule to carry out such section as
4 of the date that is 180 days after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the final rule required to be issued under
6 subsection (a) shall provide that, for purposes of such sec-
7 tion, the State agency charged with the administration of
8 the State unemployment compensation law shall determine
9 whether an occupation regularly conducts drug testing.

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
