A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to offer rewards of up to \$5,000,000 for information regarding the attacks on the United States diplomatic mission at Benghazi, Libya, that began on September 11, 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REWARDS AUTHORIZED.**

4 In accordance with the Rewards for Justice program
5 authorized under section 36 of the State Department
6 Basic Authorities Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2708), the Sec-
7 retary of State shall offer a reward of not more than
8 \$5,000,000 to individuals who furnish information—

1 (1) regarding the attacks on the United States
2 diplomatic mission at Benghazi, Libya, that began
3 on September 11, 2012; or

4 (2) leading to the capture of an individual who
5 committed, conspired to commit, attempted to com-
6 mit, or aided in the commission of the attacks de-
7 scribed in paragraph (1).

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
