1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OBSTRUCTION EVALUATION AERONAUTICAL**
4 **STUDIES.**

5 The Secretary of Transportation may implement the
6 policy set forth in the notice of proposed policy entitled
7 “Proposal To Consider the Impact of One Engine Inoper-
8 ative Procedures in Obstruction Evaluation Aeronautical

1 Studies” published by the Department of Transportation
2 on April 28, 2014 (79 Fed. Reg. 23300), only if the policy
3 is adopted pursuant to notice and comment rulemaking
4 and, for purposes of Executive Order 12866 (5 U.S.C. 601
5 note; relating to regulatory planning and review), is treat-
6 ed as a significant regulatory action within the scope of
7 section 3(f)(1) of such Order.

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
