Mr. ISRAEL (for himself and Mr. BISHOP of New York) introduced the
following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, to ensure continuing
funding for the United States Merchant Marine Academy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Midshipmen Education
5 Certainty Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUING FUNDING FOR THE UNITED STATES**

7 **MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY.**

8 Section 51301 of title 46, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

10 “(c) CONTINUING FUNDING.—

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Out of any funds in the
2 general fund of the Treasury not otherwise appro-
3 priated, there are hereby appropriated such sums as
4 are necessary for operations of the United States
5 Merchant Marine Academy for any period during
6 which interim or full-year appropriations are not in
7 effect for the United States Merchant Marine Acad-
8 emy, for fiscal year 2014 and each fiscal year there-
9 after.

10 “(2) TERMINATION.—Funds made available for
11 a fiscal year by this subsection shall remain available
12 until whichever of the following first occurs:

13 “(A) The enactment into law of an appro-
14 piation for such fiscal year (including a con-
15 tinuing appropriation) for such operations.

16 “(B) The enactment into law for the Mari-
17 time Administration of the applicable regular
18 appropriation for such fiscal year, or continuing
19 appropriations resolution for such fiscal year,
20 without any appropriation for such oper-
21 ations.”.

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
