A BILL

To amend title 11 of the United States Code to stop abusive student loan collection practices in bankruptcy cases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping Abusive Stu-
5 dent Loan Collection Practices in Bankruptcy Act of
6 2014”.

7 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

8 Section 523(d) of title 11 of the United States Code
9 is amended by striking “of this section” and inserting “or
10 the debtor requests a determination of the dischargeability

1 of a debt based on undue hardship under subsection
2 (a)(8)’’.

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.**

4 (a) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Except as provided in sub-
5 section (b), this Act and the amendment made by this Act
6 shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this Act.

7 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.—The amendment
8 made by this Act shall apply only with respect to cases
9 commenced under title 11 of the United States Code on
10 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
