Mr. STIVERS (for himself and Mrs. BEATTY) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To expand the Moving to Work demonstration program of the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Moving to Work Ex-
5 pansion Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.**

7 (a) INCREASE IN AUTHORIZED NUMBER OF PHAS.—

8 The number of public housing agencies authorized to par-
9 ticipate in the Moving-to-Work demonstration program
10 authorized under section 204 of the Departments of Vet-

1 erans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development, and
2 Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 1996 (Public
3 Law 104–134; 42 U.S.C. 1437f note; 110 Stat. 1321–
4 281) is hereby increased by 10 over the number of agen-
5 cies authorized to participate in such program as of the
6 date of the enactment of this Act.

7 (b) ELIGIBILITY.—A public housing agency may be
8 selected for participation pursuant to subsection (a) in the
9 demonstration program referred to in such subsection only
10 if the agency administers, in the aggregate, 10,000 or
11 more public housing dwelling units and housing choice
12 vouchers under section 8(o) of the United States Housing
13 Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)).

14 (c) LIMITATION ON FUNDING.—A public housing
15 agency selected for participation pursuant to subsection
16 (a) in the demonstration program referred to in such sub-
17 section shall not be provided any funding under section
18 8 or 9 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42
19 U.S.C. 1437f, 1437g) in addition to the funding that such
20 agency otherwise would receive absent such participation.

21 (d) REPORTING OF FINANCIAL DATA.—In addition
22 to other reporting requirements, all public housing agen-
23 cies participating in the demonstration program referred
24 to in subsection (a) (whether pursuant to such subsection
25 or otherwise) shall report financial data to the Depart-

1 ment of Housing and Urban Development as the Secretary
2 of Housing and Urban Development shall specify to en-
3 sure that the effects of policy changes in the demonstra-
4 tion programs carried out by such agencies can be meas-
5 ured.
