Mr. NOLAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To limit Department of Defense funds to support United States or Iraqi combat activities in or around Iraq, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**
4 **FUNDS TO SUPPORT UNITED STATES OR**
5 **IRAQI COMBAT ACTIVITIES IN OR AROUND**
6 **IRAQ.**

7 (a) LIMITATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds made
9 available to the Department of Defense may be obli-
10 gated or expended after the date of the enactment

1 of this Act to support, directly or indirectly, any
2 United States or Iraqi combat activities in or around
3 Iraq.

4 (2) EXCEPTION.—Funds made available to the
5 Department of Defense may be made available until
6 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act
7 to protect the safety and or evacuate United States
8 nationals, including military, diplomatic, and con-
9 tractor personnel.

10 (b) COMBAT ACTIVITIES DEFINED.—For purposes of
11 subsection (a), the term “combat activities” includes the
12 use of United States military personnel or equipment in
13 direct physical conflict, or in combat supporting roles, in-
14 cluding trainers or advisors.

15 (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION RELATING TO ASY-
16 LUM.—Nothing in this section shall be construed to pre-
17 clude the President from arranging asylum or other means
18 of protection for Iraqi nationals who may be physically en-
19 dangered because of associations with the Government of
20 the United States.

21 (d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION RELATING TO INTEL-
22 LIGENCE ACTIVITIES.—Nothing in this section shall be
23 construed to preclude the President from conducting such
24 intelligence activities as may be necessary to protect the
25 interests of the United States.

1 (e) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION RELATING TO HUMANI-
2 TARIAN ASSISTANCE.—Nothing in this section shall be
3 construed to preclude the President from providing hu-
4 manitarian assistance with respect to Iraq.

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
