Mr. PETERS of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 to direct the Secretary of State to submit reports to Congress on child protection compacts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as—

5 (1) the “Partnering to Abolish Child Traf-
6 ficking Act”; or

7 (2) the “PACT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTS ON CHILD PROTECTION COMPACTS.**

2 Section 105A(d) of the Trafficking Victims Protec-
3 tion Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7103a(d)) is amended by add-
4 ing at the end the following:

5 “(7) REPORTS.—The Secretary of State, acting
6 through the Director established pursuant to section
7 105(e)(1) of this Act, shall submit an annual report
8 to Congress, which shall include information regard-
9 ing—

10 “(A) child protection compacts under this
11 subsection;

12 “(B) countries with which the United
13 States may enter into a child protection com-
14 pact under this subsection; and

15 “(C) assistance provided under this sub-
16 section.”.

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
