A BILL

To amend the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 to direct the Interagency Task Force to Monitor and Combat Trafficking to develop a comprehensive action plan to combat human trafficking.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Modern-Day Slav-
5 ery Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMPREHENSIVE ACTION PLAN TO COMBAT**
2 **HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

3 Section 105(d) of the Trafficking Victims Protection
4 Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7103(d)) is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating paragraph (7) as para-
6 graph (8); and

7 (2) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(7) Not later than two years after the date of
10 the enactment of the National Action Plan to Com-
11 bat Human Trafficking and Modern-Day Slavery
12 Act of 2014, develop a comprehensive plan to com-
13 bat trafficking in persons, which shall include rec-
14 ommendations for coordination among relevant Fed-
15 eral agencies in order to—

16 “(A) assist victims of trafficking;

17 “(B) investigate and prosecute crimes re-
18 lated to trafficking in persons;

19 “(C) conduct research and collect data re-
20 lated to trafficking in persons;

21 “(D) train officers and employees of such
22 agencies regarding trafficking in persons;

23 “(E) engage with nongovernmental enti-
24 ties, which may assist in combating trafficking
25 in persons; and

1 “(F) implement Federal laws and regula-
2 tions related to trafficking in persons.”.
