A BILL

To provide certain uninsured individuals a special enrollment period after tax filing in 2015 for enrollment in qualified health plans offered through an Exchange, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Get Your Refund, Get
5 Your Health Care Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD FOR CERTAIN UN-**
2 **INSURED INDIVIDUALS AFTER TAX FILING**
3 **PERIOD IN 2015.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
5 Human Services shall require that Exchanges established
6 under title I of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
7 Act (Public Law 111–148) provide to qualified uninsured
8 individuals a 60-day special enrollment period that begins
9 on April 15, 2015 (or, if earlier, on the date such indi-
10 vidual files an income tax return applicable to the first
11 taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2014).

12 (b) QUALIFIED UNINSURED INDIVIDUAL DE-
13 FINED.—In this section, the term “qualified uninsured in-
14 dividual” means an individual who—

15 (1) is eligible, but who has not elected, to enroll
16 in a qualified health plan offered through an Ex-
17 change established under title I of the Patient Pro-
18 tection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–
19 148) during the open enrollment period for 2015;
20 and

21 (2) is liable for a penalty under section 5000A
22 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 with respect
23 to any month in 2014.

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
