3 **SECTION 1. REVISION TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF DEATH**

4 **GRATUITIES FOR FOREIGN SERVICE AND**

5 **OTHER EXECUTIVE AGENCY EMPLOYEES.**

6 Section 413 of the Foreign Service Act of 1980 (22
7 U.S.C. 3973) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a) by inserting “designated
2 beneficiaries or” before “surviving dependents”;

3 (2) in subsection (b) by inserting “designated
4 beneficiaries or” before “survivors”;

5 (3) in subsection (c) by striking “survivors and
6 beneficiaries” and inserting “designated beneficiaries
7 then survivors”;

8 (4) by striking subsection (d); and

9 (5) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
10 section (d).

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
