A BILL

To increase the unit cap on the rental assistance demonstration of the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rental Assistance
5 Housing Preservation and Rehabilitation Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO RENTAL ASSISTANCE DEM-**
7 **ONSTRATION.**

8 (a) AMENDMENTS.—The matter in the heading
9 “Rental Assistance Demonstration” in title II of the
10 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and

1 Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2012 (division C of
2 Public Law 112–55; 125 Stat. 673) is amended—

3 (1) by striking “(except for funds allocated
4 under such section for single room occupancy dwell-
5 ings as authorized by title IV of the McKinney-
6 Vento Homeless Assistance Act)” each place such
7 phrase appears;

8 (2) in the third proviso by inserting “in excess
9 of amounts made available under this heading” after
10 “associated with such conversion”;

11 (3) in the fourth proviso—

12 (A) by striking “60,000” and inserting
13 “150,000”; and

14 (B) by striking “or section 8(e)(2)”; and

15 (4) in the penultimate proviso by striking “and
16 2013” and inserting “through 2016”.

17 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
18 section (a) shall apply only to any amounts that are made
19 available for fiscal year 2014 or any fiscal year thereafter
20 for carrying out the demonstration program established
21 under the heading referred to in subsection (a).

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
