A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to allow aliens having status as an E–2 nonimmigrant by reason of a change of nonimmigrant classification made in the United States to re-enter the United States after a trip abroad without obtaining a new visa.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as—

5 (1) the “Investors Need Clear Laws with Uni-
6 form Direction for E–2 Status Holders Act”; or

7 (2) the “INCLUDE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNLIMITED RE-ENTRIES FOR CERTAIN TREATY IN-**
2 **VESTORS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
4 rity shall take such steps as may be necessary to ensure
5 that—

6 (1) an alien described in subsection (b) may re-
7 enter the United States after a trip abroad without
8 having to request or obtain a new visa; and

9 (2) there is no limit on the number of such re-
10 entries during the period in which the alien lawfully
11 holds status under section 101(a)(15)(E)(ii) of the
12 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
13 1101(a)(15)(E)(ii)).

14 (b) ALIENS DESCRIBED.—An alien described in this
15 subsection is an alien having lawful status under section
16 101(a)(15)(E)(ii) of the Immigration and Nationality Act
17 (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(E)(ii)) by reason of a change of
18 nonimmigrant classification made in the United States
19 under section 248 of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1258).

20 (c) TRAVEL DOCUMENTS.—The Secretary of Home-
21 land Security shall commence issuance of travel docu-
22 ments determined appropriate by the Secretary to carry
23 out this section, such as re-entry permits, advance parole
24 travel documents, or any other travel documents deemed
25 appropriate by the Secretary for this purpose.
