Mr. GRAYSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To create the Made-in-America Bank.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Made-in-America Bank
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REDESIGNATION OF THE EXPORT-IMPORT BANK AS**
7 **THE MADE-IN-AMERICA BANK.**

8 (a) REDESIGNATION.—Paragraph (1) of subsection
9 (a) of section 2 of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
10 (12 U.S.C. 635(a)(1)) is amended by striking “Export-
11 Import Bank” and inserting “Made-in-America Bank”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, map,
2 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the Federal agency renamed in subsection (a)
4 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Made-in-America
5 Bank”.

6 **SEC. 3. FINANCING MADE AVAILABLE TO AMERICAN ENTI-**
7 **TIES PURCHASING AMERICAN MADE GOODS.**

8 All guarantees, loans, insurance, and any other bene-
9 fits historically provided by the Export-Import Bank may
10 only be made to a domestic entity that is not majority-
11 owned by any foreign person or entity and only for the
12 purpose of acquiring goods or services made in America.

13 **SEC. 4. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.**

14 Section 7 of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
15 (12 U.S.C. 635f) is amended by striking “2014” and in-
16 serting “2016”.

17 **SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

18 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
19 on October 1, 2014, or the date of enactment of this Act,
20 whichever is later.

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
