A BILL

To amend title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act to change the permissible age variation in health insurance premium rates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Letting Insurance
5 Benefit Everyone Regardless of Their Youth (LIBERTY)
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CHANGE IN PERMISSIBLE AGE VARIATION IN**
2 **HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM RATES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2701(a)(1)(A)(iii) of the
4 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg(a)(1)(A)(iii)),
5 as inserted by section 1201(4) of Public Law 111–148,
6 is amended by striking “3 to 1 for adults (consistent with
7 section 2707(c))” and inserting “5 to 1 for adults (con-
8 sistent with section 2707(c)) or such other ratio for adults
9 (consistent with section 2707(c)) as the State involved
10 may provide”.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
12 subsection (a) shall apply as if it was included in the en-
13 actment of Public Law 111–148.

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
