A BILL

To provide for duty-free treatment of certain recreational performance outerwear, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Optimal
5 Use of Trade to Develop Outerwear and Outdoor Recre-
6 ation Act” or the “U.S. OUTDOOR Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

8 Congress finds the following:

1 (1) The outdoor industry generates
2 \$646,000,000,000 in consumer spending annually
3 and directly supports 6,000,000 jobs.

4 (2) Outdoor activities are vitally important to
5 the health and well-being of the people of the United
6 States.

7 (3) Duty rates on recreational performance ap-
8 parel are among the highest duty rates imposed by
9 the United States Government, with duties on some
10 recreational performance apparel as high as 28.2
11 percent.

12 (4) The duties currently imposed by the United
13 States on recreational performance apparel were set
14 in an era during which high rates of duty were in-
15 tended to protect the production of other apparel in
16 the United States, and before the technologies and
17 innovations that create today's recreational perform-
18 ance apparel industry were developed.

19 (5) In July 2007, the United States Inter-
20 national Trade Commission confirmed, in USITC
21 Publication 3937, that recreational performance ap-
22 parel produced in the United States makes up less
23 than 1 percent of the total recreational performance
24 apparel market.

1 (6) The elimination of duties on the importation
2 of certain recreational performance apparel would
3 provide an economic benefit to United States con-
4 sumers of outdoor products and would promote in-
5 creased participation in healthy and active lifestyles.

6 **SEC. 3. KNIT APPAREL AND ACCESSORIES.**

7 (a) **DEFINITIONS.**—The Additional U.S. Note to
8 Chapter 61 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
9 United States is amended—

10 (1) in the heading, by striking “Additional U.S.
11 Note” and inserting “Additional U.S. Notes”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following new
13 notes:

14 “2. (a) For purposes of this chapter, the term ‘rec-
15 reational performance outerwear’ means trousers (includ-
16 ing, but not limited to, paddling pants, ski or snowboard
17 pants, and ski or snowboard pants intended for sale as
18 parts of ski-suits), coveralls and bib overalls, and jackets
19 (including, but not limited to, full zip jackets, paddling
20 jackets, ski jackets, and ski jackets intended for sale as
21 parts of ski-suits), windbreakers, and similar articles (in-
22 cluding padded, sleeveless jackets) composed of knit fab-
23 rics of cotton, wool, hemp, bamboo, silk, or manmade
24 fiber, or a combination of such fibers, that are either
25 water-resistant or treated with plastics, or both, with criti-

1 cally sealed seams, and with 5 or more of the following

2 features:

3 “(i) Insulation for cold weather protection.

4 “(ii) Pockets, at least one of which has a
5 zippered, hook and loop, or other type of closure.

6 “(iii) Elastic, drawcord, or other means of
7 tightening around the waist or leg hems, including
8 hidden leg sleeves with a means of tightening at the
9 ankle for trousers and tightening around the waist
10 or bottom hem for jackets.

11 “(iv) Venting, not including grommet(s).

12 “(v) Articulated elbows or knees.

13 “(vi) Reinforcement in one of the following
14 areas: the elbows, shoulders, seat, knees, ankles, or
15 cuffs.

16 “(vii) Weatherproof closure at the waist or
17 front.

18 “(viii) Multi-adjustable hood or adjustable col-
19 lar.

20 “(ix) Adjustable powder skirt, inner protective
21 skirt, or adjustable inner protective cuff at sleeve
22 hem.

23 “(x) Construction at the arm gusset that uti-
24 lizes fabric, design, or patterning to allow radial arm
25 movement.

1 “(xi) Odor control technology.

2 The term ‘recreational performance outerwear’ does not
3 include occupational outerwear or garments with an outer
4 surface of looped pile.

5 “(b) For purposes of this Note, the following terms
6 have the following meanings:

7 “(i) The term ‘water-resistant’ means that a
8 garment must have a water resistance (see ASTM
9 designations D 3779–81 and D 3781–79) such that,
10 under a head pressure of 600 millimeters, not more
11 than 1.0 gram of water penetrates after two minutes
12 when tested in accordance with the current version
13 of AATCC Test Method 35. The water resistance of
14 the garment is the result of a rubber or plastics ap-
15 plication to the outer shell, lining, or inner lining.

16 “(ii) The term ‘treated with plastics’ refers to
17 textile fabrics impregnated, coated, covered, or lami-
18 nated with plastics, as described in Note 2 to chap-
19 ter 59.

20 “(iii) The term ‘sealed seams’ means seams
21 that have been covered by means of taping, gluing,
22 bonding, cementing, fusing, welding, or a similar
23 process so that water cannot pass through the seams
24 when tested in accordance with the current version
25 of AATCC Test Method 35.

1 “(iv) The term ‘critically sealed seams’
2 means—

3 “(A) for jackets, windbreakers, and similar
4 articles (including padded, sleeveless jackets),
5 sealed seams that are sealed at the front and
6 back yokes, or at the shoulders, arm holes, or
7 both, where applicable; and

8 “(B) for trousers, overalls and bib overalls
9 and similar articles, sealed seams that are
10 sealed at the front (up to the zipper or other
11 means of closure) and back rise.

12 “(v) The term ‘insulation for cold weather pro-
13 tection’ means insulation with either synthetic fill,
14 down, a laminated thermal backing, or other lining
15 for thermal protection from cold weather.

16 “(vi) The term ‘venting’ refers to closeable or
17 permanent constructed openings in a garment (ex-
18 cluding front, primary zipper closures and grom-
19 met(s)) to allow increased expulsion of built-up heat
20 during outdoor activities. In a jacket, such openings
21 are often positioned on the underarm seam of a gar-
22 ment but may also be placed along other seams in
23 the front or back of a garment. In trousers, such
24 openings are often positioned on the inner or outer

1 leg seams of a garment but may also be placed along
2 other seams in the front or back of a garment.

3 “(vii) The term ‘articulated elbows or knees’ re-
4 fers to the construction of a sleeve (or pant leg) to
5 allow improved mobility at the elbow (or knee)
6 through the use of extra seams, darts, gussets, or
7 other means.

8 “(viii) The term ‘reinforcement’ refers to the
9 use of a double layer of fabric or section(s) of fabric
10 that is abrasion-resistant or otherwise more durable
11 than the face fabric of the garment.

12 “(ix) The term ‘weatherproof closure’ means a
13 closure (including, but not limited to, laminated or
14 coated zippers, storm flaps, or other weatherproof
15 construction) that has been reinforced or engineered
16 in a manner to reduce the penetration or absorption
17 of moisture or air through an opening in the gar-
18 ment.

19 “(x) The term ‘multi-adjustable hood or adjust-
20 able collar’ means, in the case of a hood, a hood into
21 which is incorporated two or more draw cords, ad-
22 justment tabs, or elastics, or, in the case of a collar,
23 a collar into which is incorporated or at least one
24 draw cord, adjustment tab, elastic, or similar compo-

1 nent, to allow volume adjustments around a helmet,
2 or the crown of the head, neck, or face.

3 “(xi) The terms ‘adjustable powder skirt’ and
4 ‘inner protective skirt’ refer to a partial lower inner
5 lining with means of tightening around the waist for
6 additional protection from the elements.

7 “(xii) The term ‘arm gusset’ means construc-
8 tion at the arm of a gusset that utilizes an extra
9 fabric piece in the under arm usually diamond- or
10 triangular-shaped, design, or pattern to allow radial
11 arm movement.

12 “(xiii) The term ‘radial arm movement’ refers
13 to unrestricted, 180-degree range of motion for the
14 arm while wearing performance outerwear.

15 “(xiv) The term ‘odor control technology’ means
16 the incorporation into a fabric or garment of mate-
17 rials, including, but not limited to, activated carbon,
18 silver, copper, or any combination thereof, capable of
19 adsorbing, absorbing, or reacting with human odors,
20 or effective in reducing the growth of odor-causing
21 bacteria.

22 “(xv) The term ‘occupational outerwear’ means
23 outerwear garments, including uniforms, designed or
24 marketed for use in the workplace or at a worksite
25 to provide durable protection from cold or inclement

1 weather and/or workplace hazards, such as fire, elec-
 2 trical, abrasion, or chemical hazards, or impacts,
 3 cuts, punctures, or similar hazards.

4 “3. For purposes of this chapter, the importer of
 5 record shall maintain internal import records that specify
 6 upon entry whether garments claimed as recreational per-
 7 formance outerwear have an outer surface that is water-
 8 resistant, treated with plastics, or a combination thereof,
 9 and shall further enumerate the specific features that
 10 make the garments eligible to be classified as recreational
 11 performance outerwear.”.

12 (b) TARIFF CLASSIFICATIONS.—Chapter 61 of the
 13 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
 14 amended as follows:

1 **SEC. 4. APPAREL ARTICLES AND ACCESSORIES OF OTHER**2 **MATERIALS, NOT KNITTED OR CROCHETED.**

3 (a) NOTES.—The Additional U.S. Notes to chapter
4 62 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
5 States are amended—

6 (1) in Additional U.S. Note 2—

7 (A) by striking “For purposes of sub-
8 headings” and all that follows through
9 “6211.20.15” and inserting “For purposes of
10 this chapter”;

11 (B) by striking “garments classifiable in
12 those subheadings” and inserting “a garment”;
13 and

14 (C) by striking “D 3600-81” and inserting
15 “D3779–81”; and

16 (2) by adding at the end the following new
17 notes:

18 “3. (a) For purposes of this chapter, the term ‘rec-
19 reational performance outerwear’ means trousers (includ-
20 ing, but not limited to, paddling pants, ski or snowboard
21 pants, and ski or snowboard pants intended for sale as
22 parts of ski-suits), coveralls and bib overalls, and jackets
23 (including, but not limited to, full zip jackets, paddling
24 jackets, ski jackets, and ski jackets intended for sale as
25 parts of ski-suits), windbreakers, and similar articles (in-
26 cluding padded, sleeveless jackets) composed of knit fab-

1 rics of cotton, wool, hemp, bamboo, silk, or manmade
2 fiber, or a combination of such fibers, that are either
3 water-resistant or treated with plastics, or both, with criti-
4 cally sealed seams, and with 5 or more of the following
5 features:

6 “(i) Insulation for cold weather protection.

7 “(ii) Pockets, at least one of which has a
8 zippered, hook and loop, or other type of closure.

9 “(iii) Elastic, drawcord, or other means of
10 tightening around the waist or leg hems, including
11 hidden leg sleeves with a means of tightening at the
12 ankle for trousers and tightening around the waist
13 or bottom hem for jackets.

14 “(iv) Venting, not including grommet(s).

15 “(v) Articulated elbows or knees.

16 “(vi) Reinforcement in one of the following
17 areas: the elbows, shoulders, seat, knees, ankles, or
18 cuffs.

19 “(vii) Weatherproof closure at the waist or
20 front.

21 “(viii) Multi-adjustable hood or adjustable col-
22 lar.

23 “(ix) Adjustable powder skirt, inner protective
24 skirt, or adjustable inner protective cuff at sleeve
25 hem.

1 “(x) Construction at the arm gusset that util-
2 izes fabric, design, or patterning to allow radial arm
3 movement.

4 “(xi) Odor control technology.

5 The term ‘recreational performance outerwear’ does not
6 include occupational outerwear or garments with an outer
7 surface of looped pile.

8 “(b) For purposes of this Note, the following terms
9 have the following meanings:

10 “(i) The term ‘water-resistant’ means that a
11 garment must have a water resistance (see ASTM
12 designations D 3779–81 and D 3781–79) such that,
13 under a head pressure of 600 millimeters, not more
14 than 1.0 gram of water penetrates after two minutes
15 when tested in accordance with the current version
16 of AATCC Test Method 35. The water resistance of
17 the garment is the result of a rubber or plastics ap-
18 plication to the outer shell, lining, or inner lining.

19 “(ii) The term ‘treated with plastics’ refers to
20 textile fabrics impregnated, coated, covered, or lami-
21 nated with plastics, as described in Note 2 to chap-
22 ter 59.

23 “(iii) The term ‘sealed seams’ means seams
24 that have been covered by means of taping, gluing,
25 bonding, cementing, fusing, welding, or a similar

1 process so that water cannot pass through the seams
2 when tested in accordance with the current version
3 of AATCC Test Method 35.

4 “(iv) The term ‘critically sealed seams’
5 means—

6 “(A) for jackets, windbreakers, and similar
7 articles (including padded, sleeveless jackets),
8 sealed seams that are sealed at the front and
9 back yokes, or at the shoulders, arm holes, or
10 both, where applicable; and

11 “(B) for trousers, overalls and bib overalls
12 and similar articles, sealed seams that are
13 sealed at the front (up to the zipper or other
14 means of closure) and back rise.

15 “(vi) The term ‘insulation for cold weather pro-
16 tection’ means insulation with either synthetic fill,
17 down, a laminated thermal backing, or other lining
18 for thermal protection from cold weather.

19 “(vii) The term ‘venting’ refers to closeable or
20 permanent constructed openings in a garment (ex-
21 cluding front, primary zipper closures and grom-
22 met(s)) to allow increased expulsion of built-up heat
23 during outdoor activities. In a jacket, such openings
24 are often positioned on the underarm seam of a gar-
25 ment but may also be placed along other seams in

1 the front or back of a garment. In trousers, such
2 openings are often positioned on the inner or outer
3 leg seams of a garment but may also be placed along
4 other seams in the front or back of a garment.

5 “(viii) The term ‘articulated elbows or knees’
6 refers to the construction of a sleeve (or pant leg)
7 to allow improved mobility at the elbow (or knee)
8 through the use of extra seams, darts, gussets, or
9 other means.

10 “(ix) The term ‘reinforcement’ refers to the use
11 of a double layer of fabric or section(s) of fabric that
12 is abrasion-resistant or otherwise more durable than
13 the face fabric of the garment.

14 “(x) The term ‘weatherproof closure’ means a
15 closure (including, but not limited to, laminated or
16 coated zippers, storm flaps, or other weatherproof
17 construction) that has been reinforced or engineered
18 in a manner to reduce the penetration or absorption
19 of moisture or air through an opening in the gar-
20 ment.

21 “(xi) The term ‘multi-adjustable hood or ad-
22 justable collar’ means, in the case of a hood, a hood
23 into which is incorporated two or more draw cords,
24 adjustment tabs, or elastics, or, in the case of a col-
25 lar, a collar into which is incorporated at least one

1 draw cord, adjustment tab, elastic, or similar component,
2 to allow volume adjustments around a helmet,
3 or the crown of the head, neck, or face.

4 “(xii) The terms ‘adjustable powder skirt’ and
5 ‘inner protective skirt’ refer to a partial lower inner
6 lining with means of tightening around the waist for
7 additional protection from the elements.

8 “(xiii) The term ‘arm gusset’ means construction
9 at the arm of a gusset that utilizes an extra
10 fabric piece in the under arm usually diamond- or
11 triangular-shaped, design, or pattern to allow radial
12 arm movement.

13 “(xiv) The term ‘radial arm movement’ refers
14 to unrestricted, 180-degree range of motion for the
15 arm while wearing performance outerwear.

16 “(xv) The term ‘odor control technology’ means
17 the incorporation into a fabric or garment of materials,
18 including, but not limited to, activated carbon,
19 silver, copper, or any combination thereof, capable of
20 adsorbing, absorbing, or reacting with human odors,
21 or effective in reducing the growth of odor-causing
22 bacteria.

23 “(xvi) The term ‘occupational outerwear’ means
24 outerwear garments, including uniforms, designed or
25 marketed for use in the workplace or at a worksite

1 to provide durable protection from cold or inclement
 2 weather and/or workplace hazards, such as fire, elec-
 3 trical, abrasion, or chemical hazards, or impacts,
 4 cuts, punctures, or similar hazards.

5 “(c) For purposes of this chapter, the importer of
 6 record shall maintain internal import records that specify
 7 upon entry whether garments claimed as recreational per-
 8 formance outerwear have an outer surface that is water-
 9 resistant, treated with plastics, or a combination thereof,
 10 and shall further enumerate the specific features that
 11 make the garments eligible to be classified as recreational
 12 performance outerwear.”.
