A BILL

To prohibit the issuance of visas to, and the admission into the United States of, an alien during the 30-day period following the presence of the alien in Guinea, Liberia, or Sierra Leone.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ebola VISA Safety
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL IMMIGRATION LIMITATIONS RELATING TO**
7 **EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—

1 (1) VISA RESTRICTIONS.—Beginning on the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, no consular officer
3 may issue an immigrant or nonimmigrant visa to an
4 alien during any 30-day period that begins on a day
5 on which the alien is physically present in Guinea,
6 Liberia, or Sierra Leone.

7 (2) ADMISSION RESTRICTIONS.—Beginning on
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, an alien is in-
9 eligible to be admitted into the United States during
10 any 30-day period that begins on a day on which the
11 alien is physically present in Guinea, Liberia, or Si-
12 erra Leone.

13 (b) DEFINITIONS.—The terms used in this section
14 shall have the meaning given such terms in section 101(a)
15 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
16 1101(a)).

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
