AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire approximately 44 acres of land in Martinez, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “John Muir National
3 Historic Site Expansion Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. JOHN MUIR NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE LAND ACQUI-**
5 **SITION.**

6 (a) ACQUISITION.—The Secretary of the Interior may
7 acquire by donation the approximately 44 acres of land,
8 and interests in such land, that are identified on the map
9 entitled “John Muir National Historic Site Proposed
10 Boundary Expansion”, numbered 426/127150, and dated
11 November, 2014.

12 (b) BOUNDARY.—Upon the acquisition of the land
13 authorized by subsection (a), the Secretary of the Interior
14 shall adjust the boundaries of the John Muir Historic Site
15 in Martinez, California, to include the land identified on
16 the map referred to in subsection (a).

17 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—The land and interests in
18 land acquired under subsection (a) shall be administered
19 as part of the John Muir National Historic Site estab-
20 lished by the Act of August 31, 1964 (Public Law 88–
21 547; 78 Stat. 753; 16 U.S.C. 461 note).

22 (d) DATE CERTAIN.—The authority provided in sub-
23 sections (a), (b), and (c) shall apply only if the lands iden-
24 tified on the map entitled “John Muir National Historic

- 1 Site Proposed Boundary Expansion” are held in title by
- 2 the Muir Heritage Land Trust by May 31, 2015.
