A BILL

To prohibit the United States Department of Homeland Security from purchasing, operating, or maintaining armed unmanned aerial vehicles.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Armed Drones for
5 DHS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PURCHASE, USE, OR MAINTENANCE OF ARMED DRONES.**
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3 The United States Department of Homeland Security
4 is prohibited from purchasing, operating, or maintaining
5 armed unmanned aerial vehicles.

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
