A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving the Gibson Dam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
4 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT IN-**
5 **VOLVING GIBSON DAM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the require-
7 ments of section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
8 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy
9 Regulatory Commission project numbered 12478–003, the
10 Federal Energy Regulatory Commission may, at the re-

1 quest of the licensee for the project, and after reasonable
2 notice and in accordance with the procedures of the Com-
3 mission under that section, extend the time period during
4 which the licensee is required to commence construction
5 of the project for a 6-year period that begins on the date
6 described in subsection (b).

7 (b) DATE DESCRIBED.—The date described in this
8 subsection is the date of the expiration of the extension
9 of the period required for commencement of construction
10 for the project described in subsection (a) that was issued
11 by the Commission prior to the date of enactment of this
12 Act under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
13 806).

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
