A BILL

To revise the Uniform Crime Reports, and the National Incident-Based Reporting System, to direct the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to include information in those reports pertaining to law enforcement-involved justifiable homicides, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Justifiable Homicide
5 Accuracy in Reporting Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING OF LAW ENFORCEMENT-INVOLVED**
2 **JUSTIFIABLE HOMICIDES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of the Federal Bu-
4 reau of Investigation shall revise the Uniform Crime Re-
5 ports and the National Incident-Based Reporting System
6 to include information in those reports pertaining to law
7 enforcement-involved justifiable homicides.

8 (b) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the
9 term “Uniform Crime Reports” means the reports author-
10 ized under section 534 of title 28, United States Code,
11 and administered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation
12 which compile nationwide criminal statistics for use in law
13 enforcement administration, operation, and management
14 and to assess the nature and type of crime in the United
15 States.

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
