A BILL

To amend title 11 of the United States Code to provide additional protections for debtors from discrimination by private employers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bankruptcy Non-
5 discrimination Enhancement Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 Section 525(b) of title 11 of the United States Code
8 is amended—

9 (1) by inserting “deny employment to,” after
10 “may”, and

1 (2) by striking “solely”.

2 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**

3 (a) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Except as provided in sub-
4 section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this
5 Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this
6 Act.

7 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.—The amend-
8 ments made by this Act shall apply only with respect to
9 cases commenced under title 11 of the United States Code
10 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
