A BILL

To prohibit United States contributions to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES CONTRIBU-**
2 **TIONS TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL PANEL**
3 **ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND THE UNITED NA-**
4 **TIONS FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLI-**
5 **MATE CHANGE.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, no funds made available to any Federal de-
8 partment or agency may be used to make assessed or vol-
9 untary contributions on behalf of the United States to or
10 for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change
11 (IPCC) or the United Nations Framework Convention on
12 Climate Change (UNFCCC).

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The prohibition on use of
14 funds contained in subsection (a) applies with respect to
15 funds made available for fiscal year 2014 and subsequent
16 fiscal years.

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
