A BILL

To extend Forest Service and the Bureau of Land Management stewardship end result contracting authority, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Forest Stewardship
5 and Fire Fuels Reductions Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. STEWARDSHIP END RESULT CONTRACTING AU-**
2 **THORITY.**

3 (a) EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.—Subsection (a) of
4 section 347 of the Department of the Interior and Related
5 Agencies Appropriations Act, 1999 (as contained in sec-
6 tion 101(e) of division A of Public Law 105–277; 16
7 U.S.C. 2104 note), as most recently amended by section
8 323 of Public Law 108–7 (117 Stat. 275), is amended
9 by striking “Until September 30, 2013” and inserting
10 “Until September 30, 2023”.

11 (b) SPECIFIED LAND MANAGEMENT GOAL OF
12 PROJECTS.—Subsection (b) of such section is amended—

13 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (6) and (7) as
14 paragraphs (7) and (8), respectively; and

15 (2) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
16 lowing new paragraph:

17 “(6) restoration work, fire fuels reduction, and
18 clearing overgrowth on snowpack watersheds;”.

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
