A BILL

To prohibit the further extension or establishment of national
monuments in Utah except by express authorization of
Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Utah Land Sovereignty
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ESTAB-**
2 **LISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**
3 **UTAH.**

4 The proviso of the last sentence of the first section
5 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter
6 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting “or Utah”
7 after “Wyoming”.

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
