A BILL

To add the 9/11 Health and Compensation Programs to the list of exempt programs under PAYGO.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Never Forget 9/11 He-
5 roes Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO EXEMPT PROGRAMS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 255(g)(1)(B) of the Bal-
8 anced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985
9 (2 U.S.C. 905(g)(1)(B)) is amended by—

1 (1) inserting after the item relating to Retire-
2 ment Pay and Medical Benefits for Commissioned
3 Officers, Public Health Service the following:

4 “September 11th Victim Compensation
5 Fund (15–0340–0–1–754).”; and

6 (2) inserting after the item relating to the Vol-
7 untary Separation Incentive Fund the following:

8 “World Trade Center Health Program
9 Fund (75–0946–0–1–551).”.

10 (b) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—If the amendment made by
11 subsection (a) takes effect after the date the President has
12 issued the final sequester order for fiscal year 2014, the
13 President shall revise the order to account for the amend-
14 ment and issue a new order.

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
